<b>Decision</b>
That the Visitors' report (including the conditions and recommendations in the report) should be accepted with the following amendments.
<b>Reasons</b>
The Panel noted the visitors' report and the observations submitted by the education provider. In their observations, the education provider queried the appropriateness of the conditions relating to the lack of opportunities for learners to learn about practice in non-ambulance based settings. The Panel agreed that the provision of non-ambulance settings is not a specific requirement of the standards and noted that the education provider's curriculum was based on their recently approved full time undergraduate paramedic route. On this basis the

Panel agreed that the conditions related to standards 4.3, 4.4 and 4.5 must be removed in their entirety.
